You are warmly encouraged to nominate a candidate for this Award.

For eligibility, candidates should be under 35 years and ESP Members in good standing at the moment of their nomination.

Nominations should be sent by e-mail to the Chair of the ESP Education and Training Committee ([esp1986education@gmail.com](mailto:esp1986education@gmail.com)), by May 15th, 2015 at the latest and will be examined by the ESP Education and Training Committee and by the ESP President-Elect.

The nomination letter must be accompanied by:

1. A short explanation of the reasons for the nomination;
2. A concise CV and a list of the most relevant publications (maximum 10) of the nominee;
3. A very short description of the actual main research activity of the nominee.
